This vibrant mural, titled "Red Pines," is a testament to the thriving local art scene and was created by local artist, Phoenix Kenny. Renowned for her work as a colourist, Phoenix's style is often likened to the German Expressionist movement, highlighting the remarkable depth and diversity of her talent.

The mural is a masterful display of artistic techniques. The entirely red undercoat breathes life into the surface colours, creating a unique texture in the depiction of Phillip Island from a coastal landscape. The use of red to render the Norfolk Island Pine trees creates a striking contrast with their natural colour, adding a creative and unexpected element to the piece. The textual components of the mural, inspired by Grace Cossington-Smith's distinctive style, enhance the artwork's colour range and depth.

The 'Red Pines' mural is proudly displayed in the Conference Room at the Norfolk Island Knowledge & Learning Centre, also known as Community House, on Taylors' Road in Burnt Pine.
